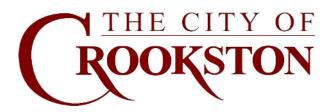

REGULAR AGENDA

8.01 Motion was made by Council Member Cavalier, seconded by Council Member Erickson; City Interim Administrator, Corky Reynolds, briefed the Council that there are some maintenance issues pertaining to the leaks in the roof at the library. Proposals have been sought, and we received one proposal from Widseth to prepare the appropriate design criteria. It was duly carried to approve the Resolution authorizing engagement of Professional Design Services for the Library. (Res No 27485)

- 8.02 Motion was made by Council Member Klatt, seconded by Council Member Cavalier; City Interim Administrator, Corky Reynolds, briefed the Council that this resolution allow Corky Reynolds to be a City employee so that any coverage from the League of Minnesota Cities would be applicable to me. As it presently stands, I am an independent contractor and that does not allow for coverage. It's not insurance or health coverage. It's coverage for hopefully no mistakes that I might make during my tenure here. It was duly carried to approve Resolution approving a City Administrator Employment Agreement for Charles Reynolds. (Res No 27486)
- 8.03 Discussion was made about the Transient Merchant/ Food Truck Ordinance. City Interim Administrator, Corky Reynolds, briefed the Council that this ordinance was originally passed in 1926 and amended in 2011. It appears from its history that it was initially made as such items as historically the Fuller Brush man, vacuum cleaner salesmen, and encyclopedia salesmen. That was the purpose at that time. As it has progressed within the past five years, most significantly food trucks have become more and more predominant. Not many salesmen are going door to door. In my opinion it is applicable to food trucks. It isn't suddenly. To people in the City, maybe it's suddenly to all of you here and the citizens in general. This year it came to light that other entities in the community planned several food truck events. The City does have an ordinance which is applicable and laid out the criteria. We have here in the city a Transient Merchant application which can be filled out and the Transient Merchant fee set by the Council is \$100.00. It does not mean that the whole ordinance is something that is applicable now. Not applicable now is that the items in a food truck be pre-packaged. That would not need to be enforced. The fourteen- day application period, although we would like that, doesn't have to be enforced. We needed to interpret this considering the food trucks and how often they are here, why they are here, and where. This is a health and safety issue. To make sure our citizens are aware that food trucks are appropriately here, registered here, and have the appropriate health certificates from the State of Minnesota. REPORTS AND STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS

Charles "Corky" Reynolds, Interim City Administrator:

Read through the questions that were asked regarding to the Food Truck Ordinance.

Darin Selzler, Police Chief:

- Patrol and investigations continue to be extremely busy with summer in full swing.
- We participated in Safety Town last week and was another huge success with approximately 40 kids participating.
- Hiring: we're still in desperate need of two Police Officers. With school out it allowed us to utilize Officer Rascott in the patrol position versus the school resource position. Obviously that helps, but it will be short-lived. In the past 30 days, I have received one application and that candidate did not meet the states requirements.
- Tomorrow at 2:00PM, we will be having our department meeting. It will be our first in-person meeting in
 probably two years. Since Covid we didn't want to risk putting all our officers in the same room at the same
 time.

Ryan Lindtwed, Finance Director:

- We have started looking at budgets and beginning that process. It is going to be a very difficult year and looking at the rise in inflation and what we have seen coming so far.
- We have done our reporting to the U.S Department of Agriculture for our intermediary loan program.
- Working with Brady Martz to finish up our audit. It falls in their court now, so they'll come back and finish up the last few questions.
- Had the Mayor in my office and finished up the last of the MIF application for Dee, Inc.
- Today we had Jordan Bergquist start, and he is the new HR Coordinator.

Tim Froeber, Fire Chief:

- We will be having CERT training down at the Fire Hall (Community Emergency Response Team training). We're
 going to do it on June 22, 2022, at 6:30PM. It will be a overview of the highwater event and if you can make it,
 that would be great.
- Thank you to the Erdman's for their donations to the Fire Department for their smoke alarm and CO detector program.
- Today was a historic day for the Fire Service. I would like to thank the Minnesota Legislators and the ceremonial signing of Governor Waltz of the Homeland Heroes Act. It's a program for Firefighters to provide assistance with expanded emotional and peer support. There will be up to a \$20,000 critical illness policy for firefighters whether they are volunteer, paid on call, or full time. One other very important part of this bill is that they will provide ongoing health and wellness training to keep our fire services brothers and sisters physical, mental, and emotional health in balance.

Chad Palm, IT Director:

- Very exciting day for IT. We replaced the very last Department Head's computer with the new surface proplatform.
- Big thank you to all participating departments in the website design committee as we reached a milestone late last week. All content from the old site was revised and we will be moving over to the new website. The next step in the process is end user training, which we will be receiving shortly. Our go live is still on schedule for July.
- The first components of our new network equipment has arrived. It includes parts for our route and our switch infrastructure. So we are moving forward with that plan.

Brandon Carlson, Public Works Director:

- We received some quotes for sandbag removal and Lyle Wilkins, Inc will be removing hopefully this week.
- Lift Station Two panel was installed. That's the first of the eleven sites.
- The local road projects: I believe they are going to start milling on Sunflower first between 3rd and Crescent Ave is tentatively scheduled.
- The City did make it through all our gravel roads and alleys, graded and added gravel last week.
- Last week the City sprayed for mosquitoes, and I wanted to thank Todd Hanson from the City of Grand Forks.
- The worst portion of the downtown sidewalks is by KROX and Widseth block. We don't have any blocks to replace them, so we are going to pull them and put cement down.

Jake Solberg, Parks, and Recreation Director:

- We are in full swing with summer activities programs.
- On June 1, 2022, I had all seasonal staff attend a safety meeting.
- Parks Crew has been busy trying to catch up with everything on the dikes and all the areas that we mow.
- I would like to thank the Blue Line Club, Hot Stove, and the Pirate Booster Club. This spring they purchased some synthetic ice and shooting tarp.
