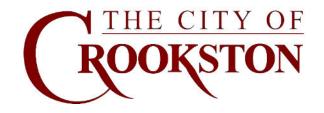

There is a desire to return the Crookston Housing Economic Development Authority Commission to be majority of public members. This Resolution designates there will be five members of the public and two members of the Council on the reconstituted Housing and Economic Development Board of Commissioners. It was duly carried to approve the modifying and restated Crookston Housing & Economic Development Authority (CHEDA) enabling resolution. (Res No. 27638)

One option is with 29 spots of campsites and one with spots as an alternative. Initially it was to be a storm shelter but, with the cost the City Council asked to see what the redesign would cost. This redesign is a non-storm shelter bathhouse. After further discussion, it was duly carried to approve the Resolution approving plans and specifications and calling for bids regarding the Crookston Central Park Campground and Redesigned Bathhouse Construction to be located in the Crookston Central Park Campground.
